As mathematicians we will be following the White Rose Maths scheme of work looking at numbers, days of the week and exploring 3D shapes.

As artists we will be developing our skills in design and pattern. We will produce an expanding range of patterns and investigate textures by describing, naming, rubbing, and copying themed around African art and tradition.

In The Natural World we will be talking about the features of our own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one to another. We will be observing and drawing different types of animals and plants.
