Dear Parents and Year 1 and 2 children, This term we will be exploring the local history topic 'How has Welbourn changed overtime?'

## Our learning challenges for this term are:

To know what life was like in the past

To know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now.

To know when some of Welbourn's landmarks were built.

To identify features of Welbourn that may not have existed in the past (electricity wires, solar panels, play equipment).

To know about the lives of people around them and their role in society (Mrs Smith)

In R.E we will: be looking at the big ideas during Easter and the Passover.

In Computing we will: be learning about robots and how to move them using algorithms.

<u>As scientists we will:</u> be learning about Everyday Materials. <u>As YI mathematicians we will:</u> be continuing our learning on Place Value and we will then move onto Length and Height and Mass and Volume.

As Y2 mathematicians we will: be continuing our learning on multiplication and division and we will then move onto length and height.

As athletes we will: be learning the skills needed to play Tennis with Miss Steer.

As artists we will: be looking at the work of the artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser. We will be recreating the Hundertwasser City.

As musicians we will: continue to develop ways of effectively using the voice, through tribal chants & layering vocal sounds in an a cappella form.

As readers we will: be reading daily within our phonics lessons but we will also be sharing our class book together daily for 15 minutes\_Y2 Children will be completing the L.E.A.D Fluency programme for 8 weeks.
